



## **RMP Certification Preparatory Course**

(30 Contact Hours)

### **Course Overview**

The Risk Management Professional (PMI-RMP) Exam Preparatory Course is designed to lead the participants to an internationally recognized Certification from the Project Management Institute (PMI®)

PMI-RMP is a Certification of international standing. Professionals having RMP Certification foster credibility with the clients for possessing a solid foundation of Project management knowledge, which can be productively applied in the workplace.

This Course fulfills the PMI requirement of 30 contact hours which a RMP aspirant is to have, before applying for the PMI-RMP Certification examination. In addition to helping the participants with this mandatory prerequisite for the PMI-RMP examination, the Course also aims to train the participants to be effective Project Managers.

### **Course Objectives**

After the completion of the Course, the participants would be able to:

- ▶ Understand the Project Risk Management Framework
- ▶ Learn about the Project Phases, Project life cycle, Project stakeholders, and key general management skills, socio-economic and environmental influences that can impact the Project risk.
- ▶ Learn about the risk impact of the Project Management Knowledge areas of Scope, Time and Cost, quality, Human Resources, Communications and Procurement
- ▶ Get an overview of the PMI-RMP Certification examination preparation process.
- ▶ Ascertain the level of readiness for taking the PMI-RMP Examination – by undergoing classroom assignments

### **Course Delivery**

The Course is an instructor led through discussion oriented participative learning, designed to enable the participants discuss and assimilate the concepts involving application of Project management concepts / techniques specified in the PMBOK® Guide (Fourth Edition) and supplementary material required for the PMI-RMP examination.

To enable a thorough grasp of the concepts taught in the classroom, the Course has been broken down into several Domains around the Risk Management Knowledge Areas. Each domain covers definitions, examples, exercises to facilitate the learning and application of the contents.

### Category 1

**Bachelor degree & 3000 hours** of Risk Management experience, spanning 3 years and **30 hours** of Risk Management education

### Category 2

**4500 hours** of Risk Management experience, spanning 5 years and **40 hours** of Risk Management education
